### **1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

**WARNING:** Read all safety instructions before operating this laminator. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or equipment damage.

- Always unplug the laminator when not in use
- · Do not touch the heated rollers during operation
- · Keep hands and loose clothing away from the feed opening
- Do not laminate items containing metal staples or clips
- Use only recommended laminating pouches
- Allow unit to cool completely before cleaning or storing
- Do not operate near water or in humid environments
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit during operation

## 4. INITIAL SETUP

#### 4.1 Unpacking

- 1. Remove the laminator from the packaging carefully
- 2. Check that all components listed above are included
- 3. Remove any protective tape or materials from the unit
- 4. Place the laminator on a flat, stable surface with adequate ventilation

#### 4.2 First Time Setup

- 1. Connect the power cord to the laminator
- 2. Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet
- 3. Press the power button to turn on the unit
- 4. Allow the laminator to warm up for 3-5 minutes before first use

### **5. OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 5.1 Basic Laminating Process

- 1. Step 1: Turn on the laminator using the power switch
- 2. Step 2: Select the appropriate temperature setting based on pouch thickness
- 3. Step 3: Wait for the ready indicator light to turn green (3-5 minutes)
- 4. Step 4: Place your document in the laminating pouch, ensuring even margins
- 5. Step 5: Insert the sealed edge of the pouch into the laminator first
- 6. Step 6: Feed the pouch slowly and evenly into the machine
- 7. Step 7: Allow the laminator to pull the pouch through automatically
- 8. Step 8: Collect the finished laminated document from the output tray
- 9. Step 9: Allow the laminated item to cool before handling

#### **5.2 Temperature Settings**

- Low (80°C): 3 mil pouches, thin documents
- Medium (120°C): 5 mil pouches, standard documents
- High (160°C): 7-10 mil pouches, thick materials

#### 5.3 Cold Laminating

For heat-sensitive materials, use the cold setting:

- 1. Set temperature to "Cold" position
- 2. Use self-adhesive cold laminating pouches
- 3. Feed document through without heating

# 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

#### 6.1 Regular Cleaning

- 1. Turn off and unplug the laminator
- 2. Allow the unit to cool completely
- 3. Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth
- 4. Clean the feed opening with a soft brush
- 5. Use the included cleaning sheet monthly to clean internal rollers

### 6.2 Deep Cleaning

If adhesive buildup occurs on rollers:

- 1. Turn on the laminator and allow it to warm up
- 2. Run the cleaning sheet through the machine 2-3 times
- 3. Turn off and allow to cool
- 4. Wipe away any remaining residue with isopropyl alcohol

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

**Problem:** Laminator won't turn on **Solution:** Check power connection, ensure outlet is working, verify power switch is in ON position

Problem: Document not laminating properlySolution: Increase temperature setting, ensure proper warm-up time, check pouch compatibility

Problem: Bubbles or wrinkles in laminated documentSolution: Feed document more slowly, ensure document is flat in pouch, check for moisture

**Problem:** Pouch jam in machine **Solution:** Turn off unit, allow to cool, carefully remove jammed material with plastic tool

Problem: Laminated document is cloudySolution: Increase temperature, ensure complete warm-up, use fresh laminating pouches

# 8. WARRANTY INFORMATION

### 8.1 Warranty Coverage

Buyounger provides a 2-year limited warranty on this laminator from the date of purchase. The warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship under normal use conditions.

### 8.2 Warranty Exclusions

- Damage due to misuse or abuse
- Normal wear and tear
- Damage from unauthorized repairs
- Use of non-recommended laminating pouches

- Trim documents to leave appropriate margins for sealing
- Remove all staples, clips, and adhesive materials before laminating
- Keep laminating pouches in a cool, dry place
- Feed documents straight and centered for best results
- Allow adequate warm-up time for consistent results
- Clean the laminator regularly to maintain performance
